Sanction of pension to widows of Freedom Fighters.
Delegation of powers to the Deputy Commissioners.

GOVERNMENT ORDER No. DPAR 67 PFS 78,

R E A D: Government Order No. DPAR 102 PFS 76
dated 9th June 1978.

P R E A M B L E: Under Rule 4 of the Karnataka State Freedom Fighters' Welfare Rules, 1969, the wife of a Freedom Fighter in receipt of pension, has to apply for pension in the prescribed form to the Tahsildar of the Taluk along with the death certificate of her husband and an affidavit sworn to before a Magistrate that her husband was a Freedom Fighter, that she is the legally wedded wife and her annual income is not more than Rs. 2,400/- from all sources. On receipt of such application, the Tahsildar forwards a report to the Deputy Commissioner for onward transmission to Government for sanction of pension.

A suggestion has been made to Government by some of the freedom fighters that the pension may be continued to the widows of the freedom fighters without obtaining fresh applications after the death of their husbands.

O R D E R

After careful consideration of the matter, the Government of Karnataka hereby delegates to the Deputy Commissioners of Districts its powers to sanction pension to the widows of Freedom Fighters who were in receipt of pension at the time of their death, sanctioned under clause (i) of rule 3 of the Karnataka State Freedom Fighters' Welfare Rules, 1969 after receipt of applications from the widows of the Freedom Fighters along with the death certificates, affidavits, etc., as required under Rule 4 of the Karnataka State Freedom Fighters' Welfare Rules, 1969.

21 The Deputy Commissioners are requested to send a copy of order sanctioning pension in individual cases to Government.

3. This delegation of powers does not cover cases coming under Clause (iv) of Rule 3 in which sanction of pension is accorded by Government in relaxation of the rules.
